### **Operational Update – Biogas Plant Incident**

Timah Resources Limited (ASX: TML) wishes to provide an update to shareholders regarding the announcement dated 10 June 2025 concerning the 33kV switchgear busbar flashover incident that occurred on 12 May 2025 at its subsidiary's biogas plant located in Sabah, Malaysia.

Due to extended lead times for the shipment of spare parts from China, repair works were delayed and were only completed on 16 August 2025.

On 17 August 2025, during the initial attempt to re-energise the plant and resume power export to the grid, a phase-to-phase short circuit occurred in the plant's 33kV underground XLPE cable. Cable repair works are currently underway and are scheduled for completion by 5 September 2025. Power generation is expected to re-commence thereafter.


As the plant has remained in full shutdown since the initial incident, total net losses incurred to date are approximately RM1.6 million. TML's insurance claim covering the total repair costs amounting to RM313,199 was successful, providing a modest but welcome offset to the overall impact.

An internal investigation has concluded that external factors contributed to the original flashover incident. All necessary mitigation measures have since been implemented to reduce the likelihood of recurrence.

While the financial impact is considered material for Q2 FY25 and Q3 FY25, there were no injuries or safety incidents associated with the event. The Company does not anticipate any long-term operational or financial impacts beyond Q3 FY25, as the plant is expected to return to full operational status by September 2025.

Timah Resources will continue to keep shareholders informed of any material developments relating to the plant's operations. The Board wishes to thank shareholders for their continued support and understanding.
