REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION - RENEGADE EXPLORATION LIMITED (RNX)

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Renegade Exploration Limited (ASX: RNX) (the "Company") requests an immediate voluntary suspension of its securities.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company provides the following information regarding this request:

- 1. The reason for the voluntary suspension is to seek further clarification on the status of mining claims recently lodged, as per ASX Announcements dated 29 & 30 September 2025.
- 2. The Company requests for the voluntary suspension to continue until the earlier of commencement of trading on Monday 6 October 2025 or when the announcement referred to in paragraph 1 is released to the market.
- 3. The event which will end the voluntary suspension is an announcement, in relation to the mining claims, referred to in paragraph 1.
- 4. The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted, or any other information necessary to inform the market about the requested voluntary suspension.
