Terramin Australia Limited – Request for Trading Halt

Terramin Australia Limited (**Terramin** or the **Company**) (ASX Code: TZN) requests that its securities be placed in a trading halt under ASX Listings Rule 17.1, effective from the commencement of trading today (Thursday, 5 March 2026).

The trading halt is requested pending a formal announcement regarding a decision of the Supreme Court of South Australia Court of Appeal regarding the matter between Terramin Exploration Pty Ltd & Anor v State of South Australia: the appeal of the judicial review decision relating to the decision made by the South Australian Minister for Energy and Mining in respect of the Bird in Hand Gold Project mining applications.

The Company requests that the trading halt continue until an announcement is released, or the commencement of normal trading on Monday, 9 March 2026, whichever occurs earlier.

Terramin is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted, and not aware of any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
