Latest Azer-cel Data Selected for Oral Presentation at 2026 ASCO Annual Meeting

Sydney, Australia, 1 April 2026: Imugene Limited (ASX: IMU), a clinical-stage immunology company is pleased to announce that data from its lead program, **azer-cel**, has been selected for oral presentation at the **2026 American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) Annual Meeting**.

Held on 29 May – 2 June, in Chicago, **ASCO** is the world's leading oncology conference, bringing together more than 40,000 oncology professionals, researchers, and investors globally. This year, more than 8,500 abstracts were reviewed by the Scientific Program Committee – selection for oral presentation represents a significant recognition of the clinical merit of the data.
