### CYG – Q3 FY26 Trading Update

20 April 2026

Coventry Group Ltd (ASX: CYG) today provides an update on the Group's trading for the third quarter of FY26.

Unaudited Q3 FY26 Group sales of \$88.2m were up +1.4% on the prior corresponding period (Q3 FY25: \$87.0m), with momentum accelerating through the quarter. March represented a step-change in performance, with sales growth of +6.5% pcp and EBITDA<sup>1</sup> up +72% pcp, reflecting the progressive realisation of benefits from the Group's "back to basics" operating improvement initiatives across sales, gross margin optimisation and cost efficiency.

#### Significant EBITDA<sup>1</sup> run-rate improvement through the quarter

A clear acceleration in monthly EBITDA<sup>1</sup> was evident across Q3 FY26, with January reflecting the traditional seasonal low with earnings stepping up meaningfully in February and again in March:

- January: (\$0.4m) – the slowest month of the year, reflecting the Summer holiday period and a quiet construction market.
- February: \$1.0m – a marked improvement as trading conditions normalised and cost-out benefits began to flow through.
- March: \$1.5m – a further step-change, with sales +6.5% pcp and EBITDA<sup>1</sup> +72% pcp.

#### Q3 FY26 Monthly EBITDA<sup>1</sup> Run-Rate

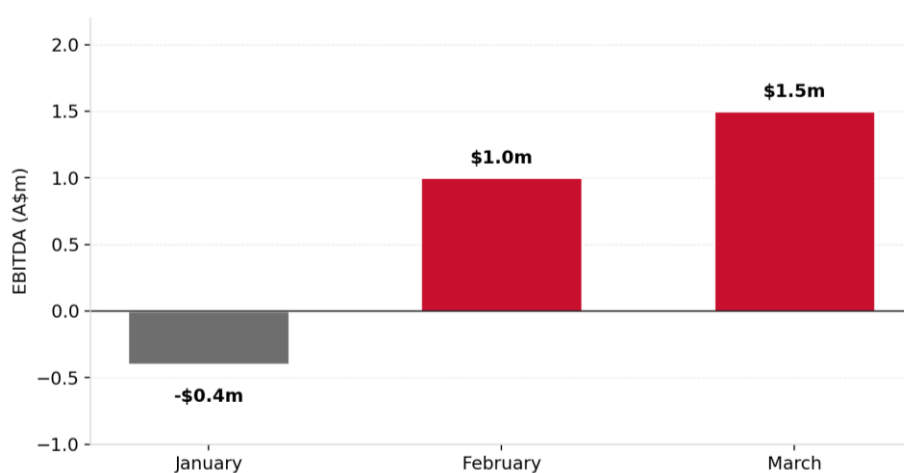


Chart: Unaudited Pre-AASB16 monthly EBITDA<sup>1</sup>, Q3 FY26

## **Cost-out program and Steelmasters integration**

Substantial progress has been made on the cost-out program and the benefits are now becoming increasingly evident in the group's financial performance. The cost-out program remains ongoing and management has identified significant further opportunities for efficiency savings across the business.

The full integration of Steelmasters over the next six months represents a substantial additional opportunity to drive further operating leverage and synergy benefits.

## **Strategic review**

The strategic review of the Company's business portfolio, announced in January 2026, remains ongoing. The Company will keep shareholders informed in accordance with its continuous disclosure obligations and will provide further updates should any material developments arise.

## **Outlook**

The Group typically has a strong earnings skew to Q4, and benefits from the key business initiatives across sales, gross margin optimisation and efficiency savings are becoming increasingly evident in financial results.

Overall market conditions remain stable, albeit with variation by region and industry. The coal sector has been more challenging, while green shoots continue to emerge across the Konnect business in both Australia and New Zealand.

Management remains focused on the progressive delivery of the "back to basics" operating improvement program and building on the momentum established in Q3 FY26.
