

Experienced mining executive Peter Doyle joins CP8 Board

Not only does Peter have a wealth of experience in all aspects of minerals exploration, development and production, he has held high level roles at ASX listed companies, and also has a strong background working in Canada, providing crucial stakeholder and government relations expertise."*

As we make final preparations to commence exploration at Wapiti in the coming months, his appointment is very timely and we welcome him on board."
