The following notional derivatives exposure information is provided for the Betashares Geared Short Australian Government Bond Complex ETF (ASX: BBAB) (Fund), as at the close of trading on 29 May 2026.

As described in the PDS (available at www.betashares.com.au), the Fund aims to achieve its investment objective by investing its assets into cash and cash equivalents and selling ASX 10 Year Australian Treasury Bond futures contracts. It is anticipated that the Fund's geared short exposure to the relevant notional 10 Year Australian Treasury Bond will generally vary between -250% and -300% of its net asset value on a given day.
