Business Update

Continued commercial execution across SimbleSense and CarbonView, with NanoSensor development program advancing in parallel.

Sydney, 15 June 2026: **Simble Solutions Limited (ASX:SIS)** (Simble or the Company) is pleased to provide the following business update on commercial progress across SimbleSense, CarbonView and the Company's broader technology platform.

Key Highlights

- **ARR of \$997k across SimbleSense and CarbonView:** Simble's annual recurring revenue now stands at **\$997k**, comprising **\$745k** from SimbleSense and **\$252k** from CarbonView.
- **Intellihub Meter Growth Continues:** Intellihub has added a further 544 meters from April to date, taking the total number of meters under management on the SimbleSense platform to 12,682.
- **Ascona Rollout Progressing Toward Completion:** Rollout of the previously announced 3-year Ascona Group order valued at \$760k (£370k) continues, with 52 of 69 sites now installed. Completion remains targeted for July 2026. Once fully installed, these sites are expected to generate annual SaaS revenue of approximately \$155k per annum.
- **Hugo Boss Pilot Expands:** Following a successful trial with Hugo Boss UK, the rollout is now expanding to three additional Central London sites, with a broader rollout to 40+ sites expected later this year.
- **Serenitas CarbonView Rollout Nearing Completion:** Completion of the CarbonView subscription rollout for Serenitas, which operates 31 land lease communities across NSW, VIC, QLD and WA, is expected by the end of this month. Total contract value is \$130k over 3 years.
- **NanoSensor Development Program Advancing in Parallel:** Following the 02 June 2026 announcement establishing the structured NanoSensor development program, the Company is continuing to advance the platform across its defined five-stage pathway. Capability-specific updates will be reported to the market as each workstream matures.

Fadi Geha, Chief Executive Officer, commented:

“This update highlights progress across Simble’s two key priorities, continuing to grow the Company’s existing recurring software revenues while also positioning the business for its next phase of technology development.

On the commercial side, we are seeing continued execution across SimbleSense and CarbonView through customer rollouts, meter growth and pilot-to-rollout conversion opportunities. With ARR now approaching \$1.0 million, our immediate focus remains on turning current activity into a broader base of recurring revenue.

At the same time, our recently announced NanoSensor development program has started to define the future shape of Simble. We see a clear opportunity to build from our existing software and energy data capability into a broader technology platform over time.

Together, these initiatives are intended to strengthen Simble’s current commercial base while also broadening the Company’s strategic growth pathway.”

Operational Update

SimbleSense

Intellihub

Intellihub continues to be an important growth channel for SimbleSense, with an additional 544 meters added from April to date across its client base, including RAA in South Australia. This takes the total number of meters under management on the SimbleSense platform to 12,682.

The continued expansion of this relationship supports Simble’s growing installed base and recurring platform usage through an established channel partner model.

Ascona Group

Ascona Group has continued the rollout of the SimbleSense platform as its group-wide energy intelligence solution under the previously announced 3-year order valued at \$760k (£370k).

Installation is progressing steadily, with 52 of 69 sites now installed and full rollout targeted for July 2026. Once complete, the Ascona rollout is expected to contribute approximately \$155k per annum in annual SaaS revenue.

Hugo Boss

Simble has completed a successful pilot with Hugo Boss UK, and that initial engagement is now progressing into a broader rollout phase.

The rollout is expanding to three additional Central London sites, with a wider rollout to 40+ sites expected later this year. This represents a positive example of Simble’s ability to convert pilot activity into broader multi-site deployment opportunities.

CarbonView

Serenitas

Serenitas is a residential land lease community operator and developer with a portfolio of 31 land lease communities across NSW, VIC, QLD and WA.

The rollout of the CarbonView subscription agreement with Serenitas is expected to be completed by the end of this month, with the contract carrying a total value of \$130k over 3 years.

Taken together, these customer updates reflect continued progress across Simble's installed base, multi-site rollout execution and recurring revenue growth pathways, with current activity increasingly translating into a stronger recurring revenue base.

ARR Summary



SimbleSense currently contributes \$745k of total ARR, underscoring the importance of continued meter growth and enterprise rollout execution across the platform.

Europe contributes \$369k of total ARR across SimbleSense and CarbonView, highlighting the growing importance of the Company's UK and European commercial activity.

Building the Technology Platform Beyond Software

Simble is continuing to build its current commercial base through SimbleSense and CarbonView, while also advancing the Company's broader technology platform through the NanoSensor capability acquired in December 2025 and held through wholly-owned subsidiary Next Nano Pty Ltd.

As set out in the 02 June 2026 announcement, the NanoSensor development program is structured along a defined five-stage pathway covering sensor fabrication, capability testing, benchmark testing, functional prototype development and customer trials. The Company will report capability-specific outcomes to the market as each workstream matures.

While Simble's near-term revenue base remains anchored in software and recurring SaaS contracts, the NanoSensor platform represents a potential extension of the Company's broader energy, sustainability and sensing capability over time, providing a clearer connection between Simble's current operating business and its longer-term technology development pathway.

Near-Term Priorities

Simble's near-term priorities remain centred on converting current customer momentum into further recurring revenue growth, while continuing to advance the broader strategic positioning of the business.

In the near term, the Company's focus is expected to remain on:

- completing the remaining rollout milestones for Ascona and Serenitas;
- progressing the expanded Hugo Boss rollout and positioning the pilot success for broader multi-site deployment;
- continuing meter growth through channel partners such as Intellihub;
- increasing ARR across both SimbleSense and CarbonView through customer expansion and rollout completion;
- progressing new customer opportunities in Australia and Europe through ongoing sales and business development activity; and
- continuing to advance the NanoSensor development program alongside the established software platform.

Together, these priorities are intended to support continued growth in contracted rollout activity, broader customer penetration and a stronger recurring revenue base over the balance of 2026, while also reinforcing the Company's longer-term technology direction.
