

RESULTS OF SCHEME MEETING

Scheme approved by the Requisite Majorities of Matrix Shareholders

6 JULY 2026

Matrix Composites & Engineering Ltd (ASX: MCE, “**Matrix**”) is pleased to announce that the Requisite Majorities of Matrix Shareholders today voted in favour of the resolution to approve the proposed acquisition of 100% of the issued share capital of Matrix by Advanced Innergy Solutions Australia Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Advanced Innergy Holdings Limited (ASX: AIH), by way of a members’ scheme of arrangement under Part 5.1 of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (the **Scheme**).

Capitalised terms used in this announcement have the meaning given to them in the Scheme Booklet released to ASX on 4 June 2026, unless the context otherwise requires.

Results of the Scheme Meeting

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 3.13.2 and section 251AA(2) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth), a detailed report on the votes cast on the Scheme Resolution is attached to this announcement.

In summary:

- 99.8% of the total number of votes cast by Matrix Shareholders were in favour of the Scheme Resolution; and
- 93.9% of Matrix Shareholders present and voting at the Scheme Meeting (whether in person, by proxy, by attorney or by a corporate representative) voted in favour of the Scheme Resolution.

Next steps

Matrix will now seek approval of the Scheme by the Federal Court of Australia (Western Australia registry) (**Court**) at the Second Court Hearing scheduled for 10:15am (AWST) on 13 July 2026.

If the Court approves the Scheme at the Second Court Hearing, Matrix intends to lodge a copy of the orders of the Court with ASIC on 14 July 2026, such that the Scheme will become Effective on that date. If this occurs, Matrix Shares will be suspended from trading on ASX with effect from the close of trading on 14 July 2026.

Implementation of the Scheme is expected to occur on 23 July 2026, subject to the satisfaction or waiver of the remaining conditions precedent to the Scheme (including approval by the Court at the Second Court Hearing).
