REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION: TON

Dear Monique

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Triton Minerals Limited (ASX:TON) (**Triton** or the **Company**) requests that an immediate voluntary suspension of all of its ordinary securities listed on the ASX be granted from the open of trading on Tuesday, 14 July 2026.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Triton provides the following information:

- the voluntary suspension is requested pending the release of an announcement on the status of completion under the Share Sale and Purchase Agreement relating to the sale of the Company's Mozambique graphite assets (**SSAP**) as set out in the trading halt request dated Friday, 10 July 2026 and to prevent trading in Triton's securities on an uninformed basis;
- Triton requests that the voluntary suspension remain in place until the earlier of a further announcement to the market by Triton in relation to the status of completion under the SSAP or the commencement of trading on Thursday, 16 July 2026; and
- Triton is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
