Aguia Resources Limited – Request for Trading Halt

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Aguia Resources Limited (**Aguia**) requests an immediate trading halt be granted by ASX in respect of Aguia's fully paid ordinary shares (ASX Code: AGR) and listed options (ASX Code AGRO.ASX).

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Aguia provides the following information:

- a) **Reason for trading halt:** the trading halt is requested to facilitate an orderly market in the Company's securities pending an anticipated announcement by the Company regarding a material fund raising (**Purpose**).
- b) **Duration of the trading halt:** Aguia requests that the trading halt continue until the earlier of such time as it makes an announcement to the market regarding the Purpose or the commencement of trading on Wednesday 22 July 2026.
- c) **Termination of the trading halt:** Aguia anticipates that the trading halt will cease upon it making an announcement to the market regarding the Purpose prior to the commencement of trading on Wednesday 22 July 2026.
- d) **No reason:** Aguia is not aware of any reason why a trading halt should not be granted by ASX.
- e) **Further information:** Aguia is not aware of any further information which needs to be disclosed to the market at the time of seeking the trading halt.
