

FIRST DIRECT SEAWEED SHIPMENT TO CHINA SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED

Highlights

- First direct commercial shipment of raw seaweed from Indonesia successfully delivered to the Company's customer in China
- Shipment follows GACC approval under the Indonesia–China Mutual Recognition Arrangement for direct shipments of seaweed from Indonesia to China
- Establishes a direct export channel into one of the world's largest seaweed markets
- Direct sales to China expected to improve realised selling prices and trading margins

The Board of BPH Global Ltd (**ASX: BP8**) (**BP8, BPH Global** or **Company**) a leading commercial seaweed supply and export Company, is pleased to advise that its Indonesian operating subsidiary, **PT BPH Global Indonesia**, has successfully completed its first direct export of raw seaweed to China.

As previously [announced on 8 July 2026](#), the shipment was dispatched from the Company's Makassar export warehouse following receipt of approval issued by the General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China (GACC) under the Indonesia–China Mutual Recognition Arrangement.

Prior to export, the shipment underwent pre-shipment quality inspection to confirm that moisture and impurity levels complied with the customer's agreed specifications.

The shipment arrived in China on **Monday, 13 July 2026** and was subsequently delivered to the customer's warehouse on 22nd July 2026, successfully completing the Company's first direct export transaction to China.

Managing Director of BPH Global Ltd, **Matthew Leonard**, commented: *"The successful completion of our first direct shipment to China represents another important milestone in the continued expansion of our Indonesian seaweed trading operations. Successfully completing the transaction from procurement through export, international logistics and final delivery demonstrates the capability of our Indonesian trading platform to service customers directly in China."*

We believe direct exports to China will continue to provide opportunities to achieve higher realised selling prices and improved trading margins while supporting the continued growth of our international customer base."

Together with the Company's established domestic Indonesian sales channel, direct exports to China provide access to one of the world's largest seaweed markets and are expected to enhance long-term growth opportunities for the Company's Indonesian seaweed trading operations.

The Company looks forward to providing further updates as it expands its direct export activities into China.

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
