COOPERATION AGREEMENT DISPUTE

Australia United Mining Limited (“AYM” or “the Company”) advises that a dispute has arisen with Forsayth Resources Pty Ltd (“Forsayth”) concerning the Cooperation Agreement dated 12 October 2020.

AYM claims that Forsayth failed to perform certain obligations under the Cooperation Agreement and issued a notice intending to terminate the agreement. Forsayth disputes and has commenced legal proceedings seeking to prevent AYM from giving effect to the termination notice.

Queensland court has granted Forsayth an interlocutory injunction, until trial or an earlier Court order, AYM may not terminate the Cooperation Agreement or giving effect to its purported termination in reliance on the termination notice. As part of the court order, Forsayth has undertaken to restrict its dealings with minerals and related sale proceeds until the determination of the proceeding or an earlier order of the Court.

The interlocutory decision does not finally determine the parties’ substantive rights. AYM has instructed lawyers to advise and act on its behalf. The Company will provide further updates as the proceeding progresses.
