Transition of Chief Financial Officer and Company Secretary

Airtasker Limited (ASX: ART) (**Airtasker** or the **Company**) today announces a planned transition in the roles of Chief Financial Officer and Company Secretary.

Mahendra Tharmarajah has resigned as Chief Financial Officer and will cease as Company Secretary of the Company, in each case with effect from 30 September 2026. Reena Minhas will join Airtasker commencing on 3 August 2026 as incoming Chief Financial Officer and Company Secretary.

To ensure an orderly handover, Mahendra will continue in his roles to manage completion of the Company's FY26 financial statements and will work closely with Reena through to 30 September 2026 to effect a seamless transition ensuring continuity for the business, shareholders and stakeholders.

The Board intends to confirm the appointment of Reena as Company Secretary for Airtasker at the end of this transition period.
