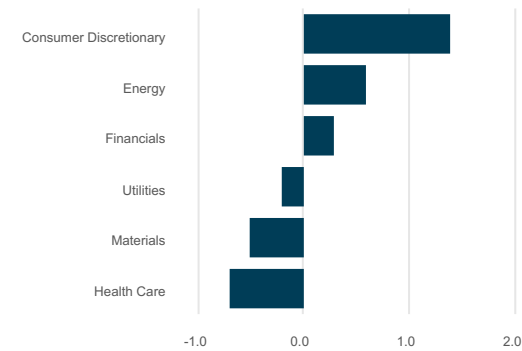
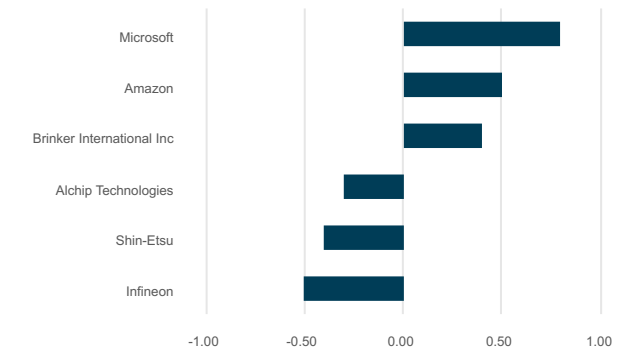

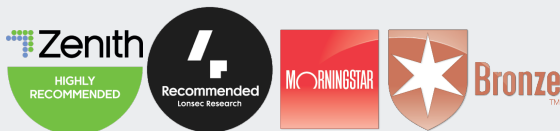

Fund features
