BRISBANE BRUNCOS LIMITED AND ITS CONTROLLED ENTITIES 2026 HALF-YEAR FORECAST ANNOUNCEMENT

In accordance with ASX listing rule 3.1, the Board of Brisbane Broncos Limited announce that the net profit before tax for the Group for the half-year ended 30 June 2026 is expected to be approximately \$11.57 million compared to \$8.69 million in 2025.

In the first half of 2026, eight National Rugby League home games were played, the same number as the prior period. Crowds averaged 42,751 compared to 40,968 as at 30 June 2025. With the increase in crowds, consumer and commercial revenue increased. Merchandise and royalty revenue increased due to the launch of new products and additional retail outlets activated.

The grant received from the Australian Rugby League Commission decreased due to the movement from the second instalment of ARLC expansion funding. The instalment of \$1.00 million per Club was received, compared to \$1.75 million per Club in the prior period.

The 2026 half-year includes the impact of increased stadium operation expenses with the growth in crowds. Merchandise cost of sales increased in line with merchandise revenue. Increase in football operation expenses were recorded due to player salary costs and an increase in medical and travel costs.

Based on current forecasts, it is projected that the full-year financial result will increase compared to FY2025. There remains uncertainty regarding the full-year position due to a number of factors including the final NRL position, the remaining home games and other variables that may affect revenue and expenditure. Accordingly, the first half cannot be taken as an indication of a full-year trend.
