

NMR delivers 870.8oz official gold outturn in August, with final smelt result pending

Highlights:

- NMR's Blackjack Gold Operations deliver 870.8oz of gold from the first three August 2026 smelts, representing a strong month of gold production.
- Four consecutive weekly smelts completed during August, producing 12 doré bars with a combined doré weight of 2,576.6oz (80.1kg).
- Fourth and final August smelt completed on 25 August 2026, producing three doré bars (BJM088–BJM090) weighing a combined 476.0oz (14.8kg) of doré, with refinery assays pending.
- Final August gold production will be confirmed following receipt of the refinery outturn for BJM088–BJM090.
- Consistent weekly smelting demonstrates Blackjack's growing production momentum and operating rhythm.

Native Mineral Resources Holdings Limited (ASX: NMR) ("Native Mineral Resources" or the "Company") is pleased to announce an official gold outturn of 870.8oz for August 2026 from three smelts at its Blackjack Gold Operations near Charters Towers, Queensland.

The fourth and final August smelt, completed on 25 August 2026, produced three doré bars, BJM088, BJM089 and BJM090, with a combined doré weight of 476.0oz (14.8kg). This final smelt is now awaiting refinery assay, and the gold contained within the latest 476.0oz of doré is not included in the official August gold outturn reported to date. The refinery results will add further to the Company's final August production result.

NMR Managing Director & CEO Blake Cannavo commented: “August has delivered another strong result for NMR, with 870.8 ounces of gold already officially recorded from our first three smelts of the month.

Importantly, this does not include our fourth and final August smelt completed on 25 August, which produced a further 476 ounces, or 14.8 kilograms, of doré. Completing four consecutive weekly smelts during August demonstrates the increasingly consistent production rhythm being established at Blackjack.

We are very pleased with the progress being made and look forward to receiving the refinery outturn from the final smelt and reporting our completed August gold production result.”

Gold Production Update

NMR's first three August smelts have returned a combined official gold outturn of 870.8oz of gold and 694.9oz of silver.

The Company's fourth and final August smelt produced 476.0oz of doré, with final gold and silver content pending refinery assay.

Across the four August smelts, Blackjack has produced 2,576.6oz (approximately 80.1kg) of doré, providing a strong physical production result as NMR continues to establish regular gold production from the operation. The final refinery outturn from the 25 August smelt will determine the Company's total gold production for August 2026.

The completion of four consecutive weekly smelts during August represents another important milestone in the ongoing development of Blackjack's production profile.

NMR continues to focus on maintaining a consistent mine-to-mill-to-smelt production cycle, with the regular production of doré providing increasing visibility over the operating performance of Blackjack.
