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Titomic Appoints Boeing Veteran Jim Chilton to Board of Directors

HUNTSVILLE, AL – Titomic Limited (ASX: TTT) ("Titomic" or the "Company"), an advanced manufacturing company delivering high-performance products and sustainment services for aerospace, defense, energy, and industrial markets, today announces the appointment of Jim Chilton to the Board of Directors of Titomic Limited, effective 15 September 2026.

Mr. Chilton will transition to the Board from Titomic's Strategic Advisory Group (SAG), which he joined in January 2026. His appointment is an important step in the continued evolution of Titomic's leadership and governance and directly supports two of the Company's key strategic priorities: Titomic's increasing focus on aerospace and defense markets and its planned redomicile to the United States.

With nearly four decades of leadership across major U.S. aerospace, defense and space programs, Mr. Chilton brings extensive industry, customer and program experience at a pivotal stage in Titomic's development. His appointment further aligns the composition and experience of the Board with the Company's growing U.S. operations, customer base and strategic direction.

Mr. Chilton succeeds Dr Andreas Schwer, who will retire from the Titomic Board in September 2026 following nearly six years of service to the Company.

DEEP U.S. AEROSPACE AND DEFENSE EXPERIENCE

Mr. Chilton brings nearly four decades of experience from Boeing, where he most recently served as Senior Vice President and Senior Advisor to Boeing Defense, Space & Security. In this role, he provided strategic counsel across some of the most complex and high-profile programs in the global aerospace and defense sector.

Previously, Mr. Chilton was Senior Vice President of Boeing Defense's Space & Launch division, overseeing a broad portfolio including the International Space Station, NASA's Space Launch System (SLS), the CST-100 Starliner commercial crew vehicle, government and commercial satellite systems, and Boeing's participation in United Launch Alliance.

He also served as President of Network & Space Systems, with responsibility spanning missile defense, weapons, intelligence and space portfolios.

Mr. Chilton is a member of the International Academy of Astronautics and served on its Board of Trustees, Engineering Sciences Section. He has also contributed to the International Astronautical Federation and various non-profit boards.

He holds a Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering from Washington State University, a master's degree from the Florida Institute of Technology, and is a graduate of Harvard Business School's Advanced Management Program.
