BlinkLab Head of iOS Development to Present at NSSpain, a Leading International Apple Developer Conference

About the Presentation

Mr Antonov’s talk, “How to Prepare Your iOS SaMD for FDA Submission,” shares practical lessons from BlinkLab’s own experience developing an iOS application to the standard required of a regulated Software as a Medical Device (SaMD). The session covers the documentation, Quality Management System (QMS), testing strategy, and privacy and security controls that BlinkLab has implemented within its iOS engineering team as the Company advances BlinkLab Dx1 toward FDA 510(k) submission.

Why NSSpain Matters for BlinkLab

NSSpain (<https://2026.nsspain.com/>) is an internationally recognised conference for Apple platform engineering, first held in Logroño, Spain in 2013. The conference attracts senior

iOS/macOS developers, including current and former Apple engineers, from across Europe, North America and beyond.

The number of iOS developers building Software as a Medical Device (SaMD) applications is growing as smartphones are increasingly used to capture and deliver regulated clinical functionality, and BlinkLab views its participation as an opportunity to be on the frontline of this emerging engineering discipline.

Participation in NSSpain 2026 is expected to support BlinkLab in several practical ways. It provides an opportunity to demonstrate the depth of the Company's mobile Software as a Medical Device engineering capability to a specialist international audience, build relationships with experienced Apple-platform developers and technology partners, support future recruitment in a competitive engineering market, and obtain feedback on emerging iOS development, privacy, security and testing practices relevant to regulated mobile health products.

The conference also gives BlinkLab an opportunity to contribute to the broader developer understanding of the higher assurance standards required when smartphone software is developed for medical use. Management believes this strengthens BlinkLab's positioning at the intersection of mobile technology, neuroscience and regulated digital health.

Dr Henk-Jan Boele, Managing Director and CEO of BlinkLab, commented: *"Building an FDA-grade iOS application is a genuine engineering discipline, and it's a great credit to Alexey and our engineering and data science team that this work is being recognised by his invitation to speak at NSSpain. It's a good opportunity to put BlinkLab in front of some of the best iOS engineers in the world, at a time when we continue to grow our technical team ahead of our FDA submission."*
