

GOLD DISCOVERY AIRCORE PROGRAM AT NUCKULLA HILL COMPLETED

ASX RELEASE | 25 September 2026

HIGHLIGHTS

- The gold-focused discovery aircore drilling at Nuckulla Hill in South Australia has now been completed
- The program tested three priority targets within the highly prospective Yarlbrinda Shear Zone, which hosts Barton Gold Holdings Limited's (ASX: BGD) adjacent 1.6Moz Tunkillia Gold Project¹
- Assays are expected mid to late October
- The pending RC drilling program has now been expanded, which is scheduled to commence in October
- The RC drilling will focus on infill and extensional targets at Sheoak, Sheoak East and Bimba

Auravelle Metals Limited (ASX: AUV) ("Auravelle" or "the Company") is pleased to advise that aircore drilling at the Nuckulla Hill Gold Project in South Australia has been completed, with assays expected in mid to late October.

The discovery-focused aircore program tested three priority structural and geochemical targets along the Yarlbrinda Shear Zone within Nuckulla Hill including the Sheoak North, Myall and Sauna prospects. A total of 34 aircore holes with 13 holes at Sauna, 9 holes at Myall, and 12 holes at Sheoak North.

Geological logging of bottom-of-hole samples is encouraging, with similar alteration assemblages to those observed at Sheoak.

Four-metre composite samples were collected for gold assays throughout each hole, with bottom-of-hole samples also submitted for multi-element analysis. Gold assay results are expected in mid to late October.

The upcoming RC drilling at Nuckulla Hill has now been expanded, and will infill and extend mineralisation at Sheoak, as well as test a number of other advanced targets, with the rig expected on site in October.

Auravelle Managing Director Andrew Muir said:

"Completion of this aircore program marks another important step in systematically testing the broader Nuckulla Hill Project beyond the known Sheoak mineralisation. While we await assay results, early geological observations are encouraging and support the prospectivity of these targets.

With the expanded RC program due to commence shortly, we're looking forward to following up Sheoak while continuing to test additional priority targets across the project."

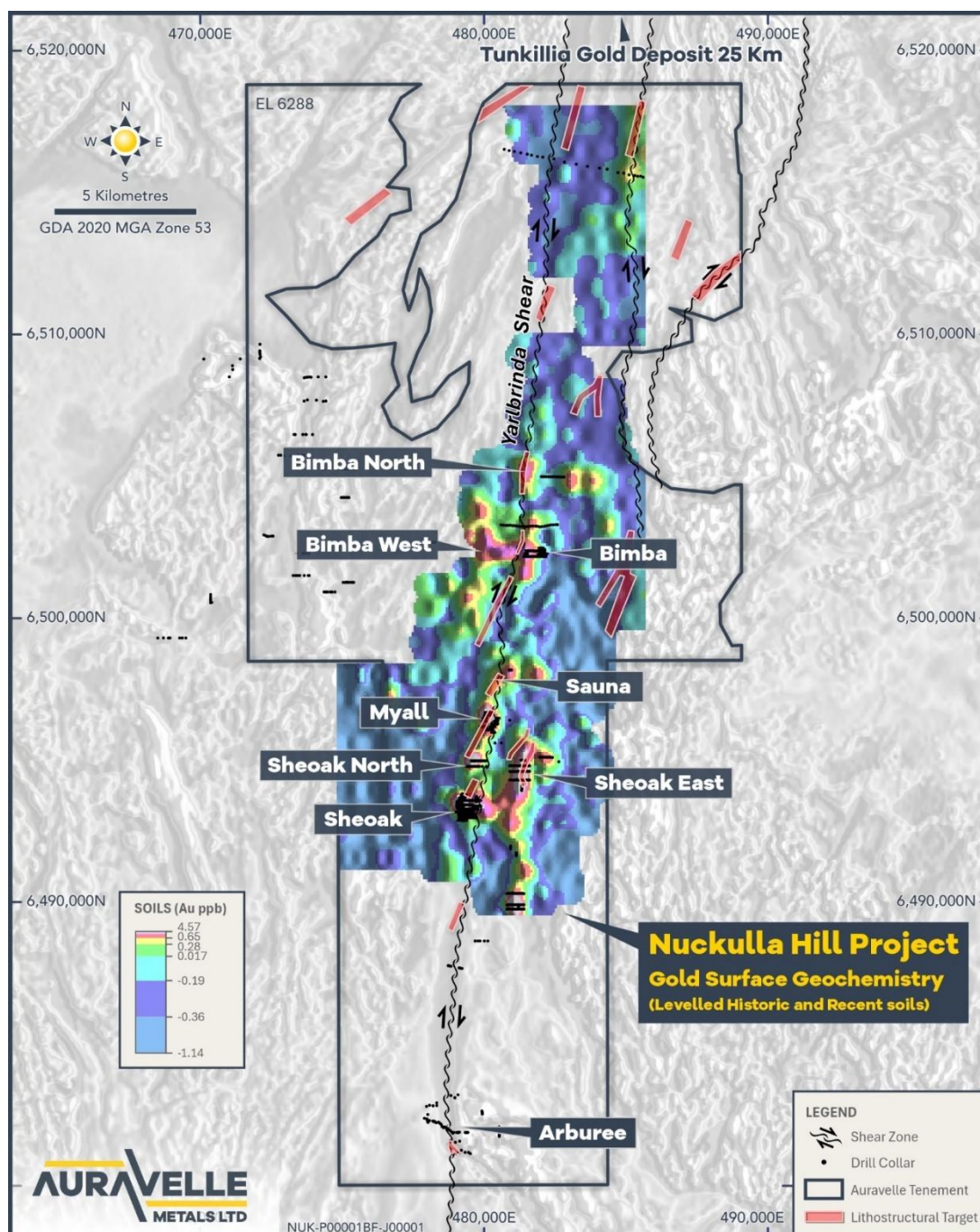


Figure 1: Nuckulla Hill Project showing Gold in Soils with Structural Targets²

Looking Forward

Auravelle is focused on advancing its aggressive exploration program with the following anticipated newsflow:

- Nuckulla Hill: Regional aircore drilling results
- Crown: Results from recent soil sampling (expected in the coming weeks)
- Skye: Results from first-pass soil sampling to define drill targets (expected in the coming weeks)
- Nuckulla Hill: RC drilling at Sheoak to support infill and extensional drilling (expected in the coming weeks)

Together, these programs represent the next stage in systematically evaluating the Auravelle portfolio.

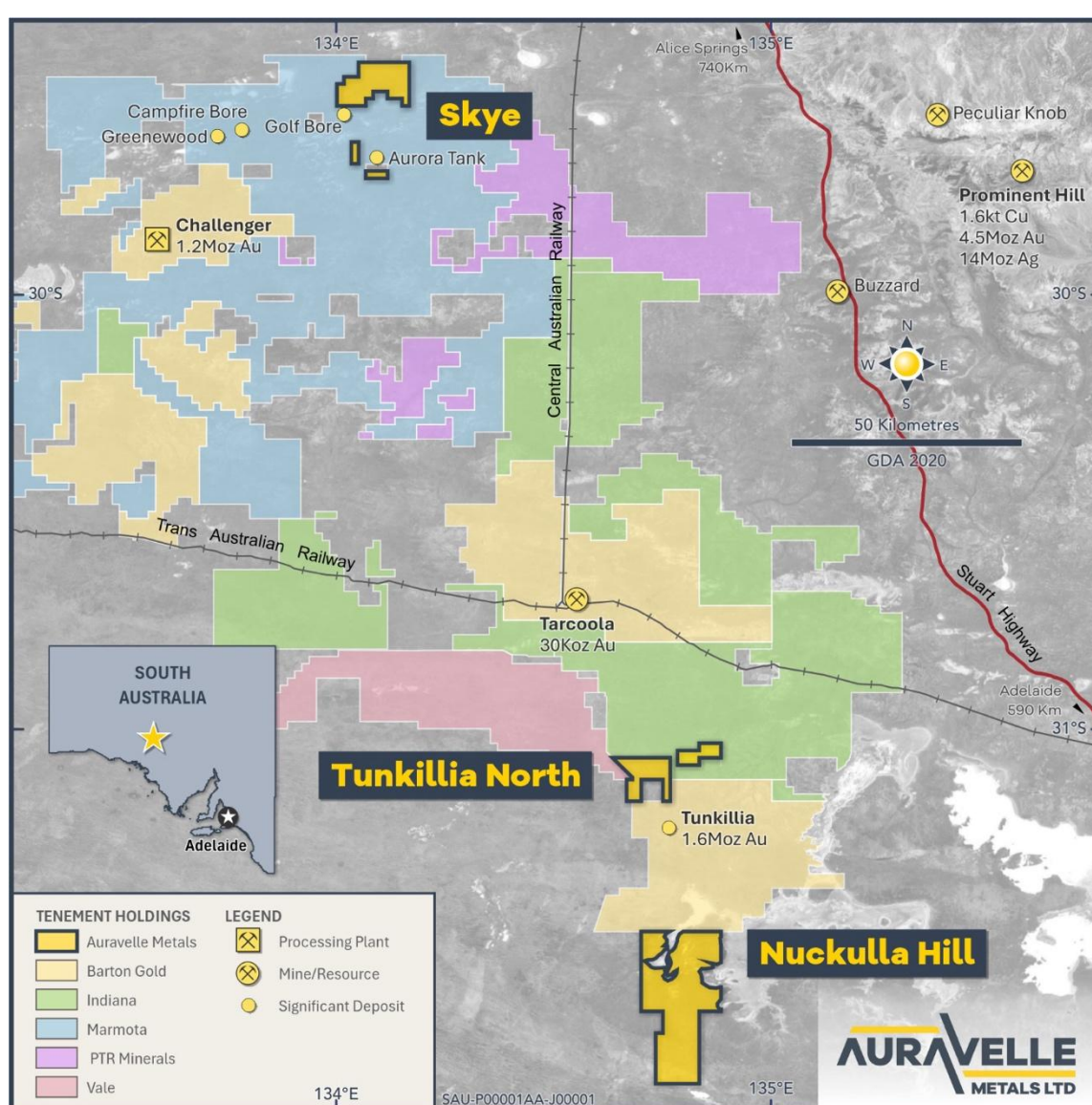


Figure 2: Auravelle's South Australian Projects³
