AUCyber expands managed SOC footprint in higher education, strong tender pipeline

AUCyber Limited (ASX: CYB) is pleased to announce continued momentum in its Security Operations Centre (SOC) business, with new contract wins and a growing tender pipeline across the Australian higher education sector.

University of New England

AUCyber has secured a new managed security services contract with the University of New England for an initial term of 12 months, with an annual recurring revenue (ARR) of over \$600,000 pa. The engagement is delivered on AUCyber's SentinelOne Singularity platform, monitored by AUCyber's Australian-based SOC.

Additional university wins

In addition to the University of New England, AUCyber has secured new managed SOC contracts with a further Australian university in September 2026 at a Total Contract Value of \$2.16m over 3 years, taking combined new annual recurring revenue from higher education wins to approximately \$1.34m.

Pipeline

AUCyber is also bidding for a further managed SOC and security analytics engagement with a major Australian university, with a potential contract value of approximately \$5.5m over the contract term. There is no assurance that this bid will be successful. AUCyber continues to participate in a number of additional competitive tender processes for managed SOC and SentinelOne services across the education and enterprise sectors.

Strategic significance

These wins and pipeline activity reflect growing demand for AUCyber's SOC capability across the Australian higher education sector, and the strength of its partnership with SentinelOne.

Comment from Shane Miller, Chief Technology Officer

These customer wins demonstrate the value of the investments AUCyber has made over several years in building a highly automated and scalable Security Operations Centre. Those investments have allowed us to deliver enterprise-grade cybersecurity services efficiently and consistently while supporting the increasingly complex security requirements facing Australian organisations.

We are also seeing a new wave of security challenges emerge as organisations adopt AI applications and autonomous agents. Through our partnership with SentinelOne, including our role as a preferred Australian managed services and delivery partner for SentinelOne's Prompt Security, we have invested early in the capabilities required to help customers govern and secure AI technologies.

The higher education sector continues to represent a significant growth opportunity for AUCyber, and these contract wins, combined with a strong sales pipeline, reinforce our confidence in the long-term growth potential of the managed cybersecurity services market.
