

EXCITE ANNOUNCES \$3.2M FEDERAL GOVERNMENT CONTRACT EXPANSION

Due to the sensitive nature and security requirements of the contract, the Company does not consider that the identity of the customer is material of itself, given it has identified the customer as an agency of the Australian Federal Government and considers that this announcement contains all material information relevant to the contract extension.

Excite CEO and Managing Director, Bryan Saba commented: “We are pleased to have been selected to continue delivering this contract with an Australian Federal Government customer. It reflects the trust placed in our team's specialist capabilities and our ability to deliver integrated technology and training solutions in complex operating environments. This is our first major contract win since completing a significant restructure earlier this year, and reinforces our position as a trusted supplier to government.”

The contract adopts standard terms which are applicable to parties on the agency's tender panel which submit business proposals. It should be noted that, these standard head contract terms include a right for the relevant agency to terminate the agreement or vary the scope or quantum of the services provided under the agreement at its discretion, as is standard under engagements entered into with the Australian Federal Government.
