EMYRIA OPENS SYDNEY EMPAX CLINIC WITH FIRST PATIENTS HAVING COMMENCED TREATMENT

Sydney opening establishes a four-state national clinical footprint, with treatment infrastructure, specialist workforce and first patients in treatment.

- **EXPANSION MILESTONE ACHIEVED¹** - Clinic successfully opened on schedule and supports Emyria's strategy to build a nationally scaled network of specialist Empax clinics.
- **NATIONAL CLINICAL FOOTPRINT** – Sydney clinic establishes Emyria's presence across Australia's four most populous states – New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, and Western Australia – strengthening the Company's national treatment-delivery platform.
- **SYDNEY CLINIC INCREASES TREATMENT CAPACITY** – National treatment bed capacity increases from 14 to 18 allowing for up to 90 dosing sessions per week.
- **FIRST PATIENTS COMMENCED TREATMENT** – Commencement of therapeutic treatment at the centre has officially begun, with further treatments to be delivered over the coming weeks.
- **REAL-WORLD EVIDENCE CAPACITY** – Sydney will increase Emyria's capacity to generate real-world clinical evidence from patients treated within regulated healthcare settings, strengthening the evidence generated through its Australian delivery platform.
- **AUSTRALIAN PLATFORM SUPPORTING U.S. STRATEGY** – Emyria continues to assess opportunities to apply its Australian treatment delivery experience and evidence generation capabilities in the United States, following its recent selection to present at the U.S. FDA's psychedelic medicines hearing² and the appointment of former U.S. Secretary of Veterans Affairs Dr. David Shulkin as strategic advisor³.

Emyria Limited (ASX: EMD) ("Emyria", or the "Company"), a leader in delivering evidence-based intensive mental-health care, is pleased to announce that its first New South Wales-based Empax clinic is now operational, with treatment having commenced for the clinic's first patients.

The milestone represents Emyria's expansion into a fourth Australian state, with existing clinics operational across Western Australia, Queensland, and Victoria. The activation builds on the Company's mission to establish a nationally-scaled Empax clinic network capable of delivering evidence-based mental health treatments for patients with post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and treatment-resistant depression.

The new Empax clinic is located within Matilda Nepean Private Hospital in Kingswood, Western Sydney, and comprises four treatment beds designed to support the delivery of psychiatrist-led treatment programs within a hospital-integrated setting¹.

First patients have been approved for treatment under the New South Wales workers' compensation scheme, providing evidence of growing reimbursement pathways whilst supporting Emyria's objective of integrating evidence based mental-health therapies into established healthcare and payer-supported settings.

NATIONAL CLINICAL PRESENCE

The Sydney opening establishes Emyria's clinical presence across Australia's four most populous states and further develops a national platform spanning patient access, workforce development, treatment delivery and real-world evidence generation.

The clinic adds four treatment beds to Emyria's network taking the total from 14 to 18, and has commenced operations with trained clinicians and Authorised Prescribers already in place.

This platform addresses a substantial healthcare need. Mental Health and substance use disorders accounted for 15% of Australia's total disease burden in 2024⁴, while the latest ABS National Study of Mental Health and Wellbeing found approximately 4.3 million Australians aged 16–85 experienced a mental disorder within a 12-month period⁵.

AUSTRALIAN EXPERIENCE SUPPORTING U.S. STRATEGY

Emyria's Australian platform is providing practical experience in clinical governance, therapist training, patient screening, treatment delivery, payer-supported access and real-world evidence generation.

This operating experience provides practical insights into the clinical infrastructure required to integrate these therapies into regulated healthcare systems beyond traditional clinical trials.

The Company continues to assess strategic opportunities to apply this experience in the United States following its recent selection to present at the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's public hearing on the potential future therapeutic use of psychedelic drugs², and the appointment of former U.S. Secretary of Veterans Affairs Dr David Shulkin as Strategic Advisor³.

Emyria Executive Chair Greg Hutchinson commented:

"The opening of our Sydney clinic establishes Emyria across Australia's four most populous states and adds further specialist clinical infrastructure to support the delivery of these treatments at scale.

"With trained clinicians, Authorised Prescribers, treatment capacity and approved patients now in place, our focus is on converting this platform into improved patient outcomes, increased treatment volumes and high-quality real-world evidence."

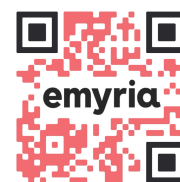
